C & P Medical Trading Ltd is committed to achieving Net Zero emissions by 2050. We will keep this date under review, bringing it forward if possible as our carbon reduction plans develop.

We have also set the following near-term targets:

- 50% absolute reduction in Scope 1 emissions by 2030
- 25% absolute reduction in Scope 2 emissions by 2030
- 5% per year reduction in total emissions relative to turnover per year up to 2030

Emissions reduction targets

The organisation is committed to achieving Net Zero emissions by 2050 at the latest. We will keep this date under review, bringing it forward if possible as our carbon reduction plans develop.

Carbon Reduction Projects

Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives

The following environmental management measures and projects have been completed:

- The organisation achieved Green Small Business Certification in February 2024, having developed an environmental policy and comprehensive action plan addressing all of the significant environmental impacts of the business.
- Business travel has been reduced through extensive use of video-conferencing.
- Implemented bulk ordering from suppliers to reduce delivery frequency and rarely resort to air freight.
- Separate waste and recycling streams for plastic, cardboard, glass and general waste.

Planned Carbon Reduction Initiatives

Our environmental action plan commits us to the implementation of further measures which we anticipate will reduce the carbon intensity of the business, such as:

- Conduct an energy audit to examine whether emissions reductions are feasible by exploring:
 - Procurement of 'deep green' renewable electricity
 - Installation of on-site solar PV
 - Further improvements in the energy efficiency of the building
- Transitioning to electric company vehicles when feasible.
- Implementing a 'use of transport' policy to ensure that emissions from business travel are consistently low.
- Reducing paper usage by implementing a new IT infrastructure.
- Incorporate carbon-related questions into our existing supplier due diligence form.
- Ensuring environmentally responsible purchasing for all goods and services.
- Providing our staff with information on environmentally responsible behaviour whilst working remotely and facilitating good practice.


This Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with PPN 06/21 and associated guidance and reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans.
